PLANTS IN THEIR ENVIRONMENT (UNIT 1) pages 12-15

- 1. Complete:
  - Plants **react** to <u>light</u>, <u>water</u> and <u>contact</u>.
  - Trees that **lose** their leaves are called [*se llaman*] deciduous.
  - Trees that **keep** their leaves are called <u>evergreen</u>.
  - Plants bloom (produce flowers) in <u>spring</u>\*.
    \*Plants usually [habitualmente] bloom in spring.
- 2. What is **pollination**?

Pollination is the travel of pollen from one flower to another flower.

What animals carry pollen?

Bees, birds, butterflies and bats can carry pollen when they are <u>among</u>\* flowers.

3. What are the 4 stages of reproduction function in plants?

The four stages are: pollination, fertilisation, seed and fruit formation and germination.
