 In an ecosystem, what's the difference between the biotope and the biocenosis? The biotope includes the non-living parts of the ecosystem (air, water, soil...) while\* the biocenosis includes the living components (animals and plants, fungi, etc.).

\*while: "mientras que...", usado para comparar.

- Tell me what the biotope and the biocenosis are in a **desert**:

The biotope is the air, the sun and the sand and the biocenosis is the cactus, the palm tree and the desert fox.

2. What's the difference between **aquatic**, **land** and **mixed** ecosystems? Write examples.

In aquatic ecosystems, the biotope is covered with water (for example, rivers, lakes and seas), while in land ecosystems the biotope is not covered with water (forests and deserts) and in mixed ecosystems land and water meet (marshes and beaches, for example).
