- 1. When does fertilisation happen?

Fertilisation happens when an ovule and a spermatozoon join together to form a zygote.

- 2. What is the difference between a zygote and an embryo? The zygote is unicellular while the embryo is multicellular.
- 3. What is the name of the protective bag that the embryo grows inside? The protective bag where the embryo grows is called the amniotic sac.
 - 4. * What organ develops in the uterus during the first trimester and why?

 During the first trimester the placenta develops in the uterus to exchange substances (nutrients, oxygen, waste) between the mother and the baby.

 - 5. What is the purpose of the umbilical cord?

The purpose of the umbilical cord is to link (connect) the foetus to its mother. The umbilical cord carries nutrients and oxygen to the baby and removes its waste.
