1. What are the main characteristics of...?:
 - Vertebrates:
 - They have got internal skeleton (with vertebral column or backbone).
 - They have got head, trunk and limbs (extremities).
 - Invertebrates:
 - They **haven't got** internal skeleton or vertebral column.
 - They are oviparous.
 - Some invertebrates are protected by a hard shell (exoskeleton).

 - Reptiles lay **eggs** (to reproduce).
 - Fish have **gills** to breathe underwater.
 - Most of the birds can **fly** (to move).
 - Mammals nurse (feed) their young with **milk**.
